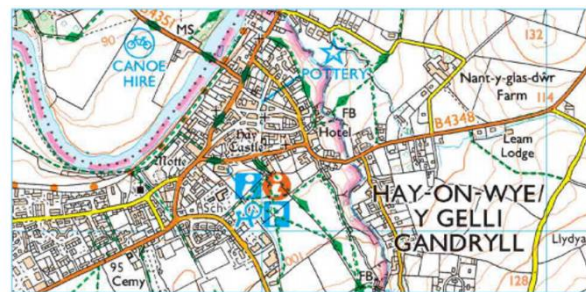
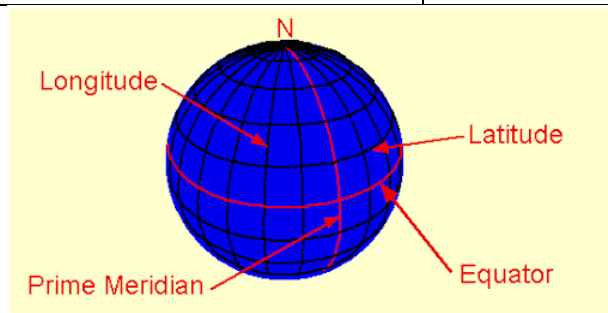




Key Vocabulary

★ Latitude lines	Imaginary lines extending around the Earth horizontally. They measure how far north or south an object is on the Earth.
★ Longitude lines	Imaginary lines running vertically around the Earth. These lines are called meridians, and measure how far east or west an object is.
★ Equator	An imaginary line that splits the world into Northern Hemisphere and the Southern Hemisphere.
★ Greenwich Meridian	An imaginary line that separates east from west. It is the most important longitude line.
★ Hemisphere	A half of the earth, usually as divided into northern and southern halves by the equator, or into western and eastern halves by an imaginary line passing through the poles.
