



Key Vocabulary	
★ Anglo-Saxon	Hundreds of years ago the Anglo-Saxons lived in and ruled England. They were descended from three different peoples. The Angles and Saxons came from different parts of Germany and the Jutes came from Denmark. They first arrived in England in about 450 AD.
★ Vikings	The Vikings were Scandinavian sea explorers, traders and warriors. They came from Denmark, Norway and Sweden. The word Viking means 'pirate' and the Vikings first began to raid England in the late 700's. Some Vikings later settled in England.
★ Normans	The Normans were descendants of Vikings who had settled in Northern France. The Normans invaded England and took control in 1066.
★ Invade	To enter as an enemy, using an army, in order to take over or rob.
★ Settle	To make a home in a new place,
★ Dane Law	The law in the parts of England that were ruled by the Vikings until 1066. The other parts were mainly controlled by the Anglo-Saxons.
