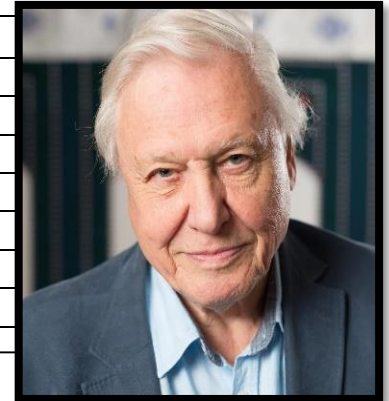

### Key people:

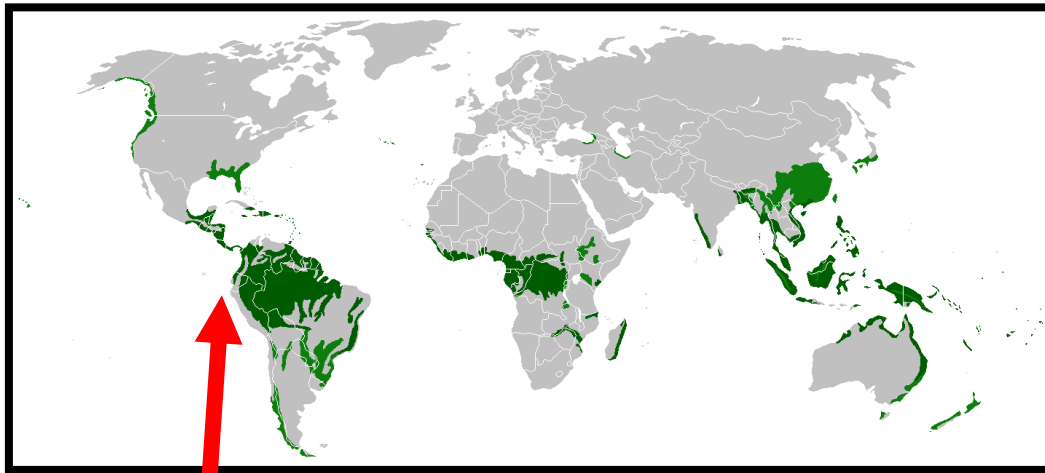
David Attenborough
