

Summer Two- Reception 'Home Learning'

Here are some ways you can help your child at home this term.

Literacy

Practise reading and writing tricky words.

Practise reading your home reading books, by sounding out and blending.

Talk about your favourite characters in the storybooks you bring home. What happened at the start of the story? What happened next? What happened at the end of the story? Which new words are in the book?

Talk homework

What would you like to do when you grow up and why? Practise talking about what you want to be when you grow up. The children will tell the class later in the term.

Mathematics

Practise reading and writing numbers to 20.

Practise recalling number facts of 5, such as $3+2=5$, $5-1=4$.

Sing the doubles song and practise recalling doubles.

Feel the weight of some objects and say if they feel lighter or heavier than each other.

Other optional activities

Investigate floating and sinking. Which objects float? Which objects sink?

Go for a Summer Walk in the park. What can you spot?

Go on a bus or tube journey.
