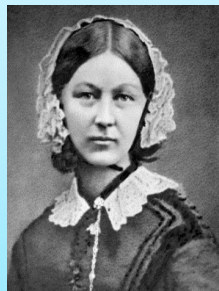
A Suffix is a letter or group of letters added at the end of a word which makes a new word.

-ment -ness -ly -less -ful

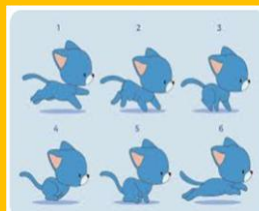
