Dear Parents,

Our names are Mrs Albkri (Year 1 Taff teacher) and Mrs Boujettef (Year 1 Humber teacher) and we would like to welcome you back to a new school year. We are very excited about teaching your children this year and we are already impressed with how well they have settled into the new routines and the effort they have been putting into their learning and behaviour.

We are also extremely lucky to have Mrs Anwoir, Miss D supporting the children in class. We would just like to inform you of some important and useful information that will hopefully help you and your child settle into Year 1.

In the morning:

School starts at 8.45am. The children should enter through the front gate by the office and line up to be collected by the class teacher.

At the end of the day:

Please **ensure you collect your child at 3:00pm** from their teacher in the back playground. Please let us (and the office) know ahead of time if you have made alternative collection arrangements, especially if it is someone unfamiliar to us.

PE:

Your child will have two PE sessions each week on **Wednesday**. Please ensure they come to school in the correct PE kit. They do not need to change into their uniform.

- a plain white T-shirt
- navy bottoms
- navy shorts
- black plimsolls or trainers.

Water Bottles:

Your child needs to bring a water bottle to school with them. This bottle will stay in their class and will be available to them as and when they need a drink.

Reading Books & Records:

Your child will bring a reading book home every Monday. Please keep the book for the week and return it on Friday. It is important that your child reads for at least 10 minutes every night and the reading diary is signed.

Homework:

Pupils will be given homework on a Monday and this should be completed by Friday. The homework will go over the learning covered in class. Your child will be given: spellings, maths and reading.

If you would like to talk to the class teacher for any reason, then we will be available to speak on the phone with you on **Wednesday between 3:15 – 3:45pm**. Please call the office in advance to make an appointment.
