Dear Parents,

Our names are Mr Bain and Mrs Chmaissani and we would like to welcome you back to a new school year. We are very excited about teaching your children this year and we are already impressed with the effort and attitude they have been showing towards their learning and behaviour.

We are also extremely lucky as we have Ms Greenidge and Ms Ahmed supporting the children in class. We would just like to inform you of some important and useful information that will hopefully help you and your child settle into Year 3.

In the morning:

Please arrive at 8.45am. It is very important that your child is in school and on time. Good attendance and punctuality are essential if children are to make good progress in school. If your child will not be in school, please call the school office to let us know. If your child is late, please sign them in at the school office.

At the end of the day:

Please **ensure you collect your child at 3:15pm** from their teacher in the back playground. Please let us (and the office) know ahead of time if you have made alternative collection arrangements, especially if it is someone unfamiliar to us.

School uniform:

Please clearly label all your child's uniform with their **name**. It is especially important to write your child's name in their **jumper**.

PE:

Both Year 3 classes will have PE on **Thursday and Friday afternoons**. The correct uniform must be worn:

- A plain white T-shirt
- Navy bottoms/shorts
- Black plimsolls or trainers

On **PE days**, children come to school wearing their school uniform and bring their PE kit to change into later.

Water Bottles:

Your child needs to bring a water bottle to school with them. This bottle will stay in their classroom and will be available to them as and when they need a drink.

Reading Books & Records:

Please ensure that your child reads for at least **20-30 minutes every night** – especially as this counts as their homework. Your child needs to:

- Write the pages they have read and the title of their book
- Write a comment about what they have read
- Get a parent or guardian to sign it every evening where possible
- Bring the signed reading record and reading book to school **every day**

Homework:

Pupils will be given homework on a Monday. The homework will revise work covered in class. Your child will be given: spellings, grammar, maths and a reading comprehension.

Spellings and times tables should be completed by Friday to prepare for a test. Literacy Planet and MyMaths should be completed by the following Monday.
