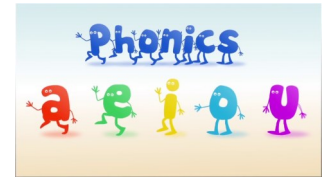


Reading in Reception

Phonics

In Reception, children learn to read using phonics. Our school follows a program called Letters and Sounds. The children have been taught the following Phase 2 sounds this term:



s a t p i n m d g o c k h e u r h b f ff l ll ss

When learning to blend words such as 'cat', the children are taught to sound out 'c-a-t' and blend the sounds together.

It is important to use the letter sounds NOT the letter names when learning to read.

Please practise reading and writing these letters using the letter mats in the Phonics pack.

Tricky words

Reception have been learning the tricky words:

I no go the to



These are words which are read on sight, they do not sound out.

Please practise reading these tricky words using the flashcards in the Phonics pack.

Home Reading

Reception take home two reading books each week. The small reading book is for the children to practise sounding out and blending, and they read this book to you with your help. The big storybook is for you to read and enjoy with your child. Your child has a 'Reading day' each week when they will read with an adult. Please make sure your child brings their reading books in the plastic book bag on their reading day.



Please read every night and sign your child's reading record every week.
