Activity	Tips	Notes:
Beginning	• Keep it short • Brief, capture the attention of the audience and state purpose of the speech. • Make it unique	
Middle	• Include interesting facts • Add examples • Try to have a powerful statement to lead into each new point	
Ending	• Short statement relating back to the topic • Sum up the subject and purpose of the speech. • Make it brief, but memorable. • CHALLENGE: Memorise your conclusion, so your last couple of sentences can be delivered with confidence and with full eye contact with the audience.	
Practice	• By yourself, take time to read your speech aloud • Practise using your notes (or you may want to write them on cards), first by yourself, then either in front of family
